- 2. Cumulative GPA 2.80 and above (based on a 4.0 scale)
- 3. SAT score 850 minimum or ACT score 16 minimum (incoming students)
- 4. Participation in extra-curricular, community service and/or leadership activities
- 5. Acceptance letter from the University or proof of enrollment (current students)
- 6. Membership in the Alabama A&M University Pre-Alumni Association

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Completed application
- 2. Essay completion
- 3. Autobiography completion
- 4. Two (2) recommendations (one preferred from an AAMU Alum)
- 5. Current Transcript
- 6. An interview with the MAAC Scholarship Committee
- 7. A wallet size photograph. Digital format is preferred.

ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT

- 1. Decisions rendered by the Scholarship Committee are final.
- 2. Scholarship awards are one-time awards. Students may reapply for each scholarship of-fered, although this does not guarantee automatic approval.
